The Pulaski County Tourism Bureau is working with the event planners for the Joint CBRN conference, aka Chemical Conference, scheduled for June 24-27, 2007. The conference is expected to draw over 1,000 people. Approximately 50% will be government travelers and may be qualified for federal per diem rates, where available. Due to the size of the event and expected sellout of rooms, the Pulaski County Tourism Bureau has requested Fort Leonard Wood to ask for an exception conference rate allowance during this time to allow those government travelers to be reimbursed at a higher rate. I will keep everyone posted.

The CBRN planners have requested lodging partners that submit a bid have complimentary internet access and offer complimentary breakfast. Since this is a government related event, participating lodging partners must also have a valid FEMA number. There are also a limited number of sponsorships available. The sponsorship is either \$500 per property or 2 complimentary rooms from 6/23-6/27. Sponsoring lodging partners will receive a logo placement on the registration website with a hyperlink that clicks through to the reservation system. All other participating lodging partners will be listed with contact information and rates, but no hyperlink. Pulaski County, along with Lebanon and Rolla will also have their tourism websites listed for additional lodging information.

If your property meets the meeting requirements and you would like to submit a room block, please submit the information along with the FEMA number to the Pulaski County Tourism Bureau by December 29, 2006. Block rooms under, "FLW Chemical Conference" heading. If you need additional information contact the Tourism Office.
