

## Museums of Fort Leonard Wood, Pulaski County Missouri

Fort Leonard Wood features a state of the art museum complex. Three indoor museums are located off South Dakota and Nebraska and feature detailed, history displays of the Engineer, Military Police and Chemical Corp divisions of the United States Army. Walk through the tunnels of Vietnam, see a bridge builder, walk thru Check Point Charlie, and shoot an M-16.

The WWII Building Museum is located just across the street. This complex let's you step back in time to experience soldiers living quarters; from the WWII, Vietnam and Korean War eras, mess hall, field chow, chapel, supply office. See the history of the German prisoners that were housed at Fort Leonard Wood and learn about segregation during the early years.

The museum complex also offers vintage military vehicles and Soldiers Memorial Park which honors our fallen.
