Quiet, relaxing adventure. Nature at its best. Scenic bluffs, wildflowers abound. Floating the Big Piney or Gasconade Rivers is truly an experience everyone should enjoy. Your choice; canoe for two, raft for the family, go it solo in a kayak or head down stream in a group on inner tubes... Ten outfitters offer a variety of 4, 7, 9, 11 or overnight float trips.

The Big Piney River runs north and south, Float south of Fort Leonard Wood through Duke Missouri or north of the Fort through the Devil's Elbow.

The Gasconade River, a tributary of the Missouri River, flows north easterly with accesses north of Waynesville, to Dixon Missouri. The Gasconade is the longest, curviest river in Missouri, measuring out to 265 miles long.

Both rivers are known for fantastic small mouth bass fishing.
