

## Frog Rock, Waynesville, Missouri

Overlooking the town of Waynesville is the infamous Frog Rock, also known as W.H. (Waynesville Hill) Croaker. Frog Rock was born in 1998 after the Missouri Department of Transportation widened Historic Route 66 to three lanes. Locals remarked on the rock jutting from the hillside, and the general consensus was that it resembled a frog, a local tattoo artist volunteered to paint WH Croaker. In recent years the US Marines stationed on Fort Leonard Wood have maintained his resting area and paint scheme.
