

Miller Cave – Fort Leonard Wood

Miller Cave is part of a cave complex in the bluffs above the Big Piney River. This cave contains archaeological evidence that people occupied this area between 7,000 B.C. and A.D. 1400.

The cave has a total of four entrances. The primary entrance is located approximately 150 feet above the river, two more openings face the river and afford a spectacular view of the Big Piney River valley.
