

Underwater Cave Diving, Waynesville, Missouri

Very few towns can boast this type of extreme spelunking opportunity. Roubidoux Spring is a notable landmark freshwater spring. It is often mentioned as one of the best cave diving springs in the country and is routinely allowed to QUALIFIED and certified cavern or cave divers. ALL DIVERS must register at the Waynesville Police Department for permission before entering. The spring rises up from the base of a bluff parallel to Roubidoux Creek. One of the longest siphon caves in the world at 5893 feet. The cave opening is wide but low. There are two caverns within, the "Big Room" and the "Second Big Room". Formations are visible from fifteen to thirty feet.
